HIST 2.75 or Higher Cumlative GPA 496 may be counted towards the UL elective requirement for the major but will not count as a 400 level course. 3.0 or Higher Major GPA A student who takes summer courses can potentially lower the number of registered credit hours in the History Total hours 12 "C"or better in all coursework 495 and History 496 semesters to 13 and 12 credit hours respectively. The same is true for Fall 2 and Fall 3 semesters.
