Minimum Requirements for the Nursing Program are: 1.) Submit an Application before January 15th 2.) Have at least 5 prerequisites complete 3.) Have a C or better in all prerequisites 4.) Meet the reading requirement by: a.) Having a 24 or higher on ACT reading sub-score or b.) Successful completion of a reading comprehension exam. Qualified applicants are competitively reviewed primarily based on their prerequisite GPA and secondarily on overall GPA and number of prerequisites completed. Admission to the Nursing Program is limited and competitive. Pick 5 (in consultation with advisor):

AHLS 211, AHRS 327, AHRS 472, AHRS 493, CHEM 230/231, COMD 220, NUTR 201, PHHE 295, PSYC 316, HSCI 217, AHRS 497, or other courses as approved by advisor.

Notes/Comments: This plan is an example of what a four year plan could look like for a typical student. Placement exam scores in math as well as the
