Minimum Requirements for the Nursing Program are: 1.) Submit an Application before January 15th 2.) Have at least 5 prerequisites complete 3.) Have a C or better in all prerequisites 4.) Meet the reading requirement by: a.) Having a 24 or higher on ACT reading sub-score or b.) Successful completion of a reading comprehension exam. Qualified applicants are competitively reviewed primarily based on their prerequisite GPA and secondarily on overall GPA and number of prerequisites completed. Admission to the Nursing Program is limited and competitive.
